Tuition 2012 – 2013

Fort Worth Diocesan schools charge tuition based upon the actual cost to educate a student. This enables the school to provide the highest possible quality in terms of faculty, staff, program and materials. Tuition rates are posted in the school admission packet, available at the school office.

Registration Fee \$ 250 per student
The Registration Fee is non-refundable unless Holy Cross Catholic School cannot accommodate the student. Registration fee does not apply to tuition.

Testing Fee – Kindergarten and Grade 1 \$ 50

Tuition Payment Options

FACTS Tuition Management Electronic bank draft

- 11 monthly payments beginning July 2012 with final payment in month of May 2013
- Option to have bank draft on the 5th or 20th of each month
- OR: Full payment on or before June 10 2012 to receive a 5% discount
- Registration with FACTS on line – register via link on school website

TUITION ASSISTANCE

In 2006, Bishop Kevin Vann appointed a task force to develop a long-range business plan that would support the financial stability of existing Catholic schools in the Diocese of Fort Worth and provide a framework for the establishment of new Catholic schools in the Diocese. One of the major recommendations of this group was for diocesan schools to charge tuition based upon the actual cost to educate a student. This enables schools to provide the highest possible quality in terms of faculty, staff, program and materials. However, tied to this recommendation was that a program of need-based tuition assistance support the cost-based tuition model.

Accordingly, to provide families whose financial resources that might not otherwise allow the family access to Catholic school education, The Diocese of Fort Worth established the **Bishop's Scholars Fund** and each school in the Diocese also provides tuition assistance for families.

Needs Assessment Process

All tuition-assistance in the Diocese will be strictly need-based as determined by an independent needs assessment process. Each school year, all families wishing to be considered for tuition assistance, either through the Diocese or the school, must complete an application for the **Bishop's Scholars Fund** and submit the application and all required supporting documentation to the Private School Aid Service (PSAS). Although applications will be accepted throughout the school year, the priority deadline for spring awards is March 1. The **Bishop's Scholars Fund** will notify parents of awards in April and August. After diocesan funds have been awarded, all completed applications will be also considered for school assistance. Families may receive assistance from both the Diocese and the school. Families who have multiple children attending the school may apply for each student. Only one application per family needs to be completed each year.

Applications for the **Bishop's Scholars Fund** are available beginning in January of each year. Applications may be obtained through the school, through the Catholic Schools Office at the Diocese of Fort Worth or online at www.psas.org.
